About the game

We are glad to offer you the second version of the popular and interesting game “One for All 250 Solitaires Collection” – 250 solitaires are gathered in one program. 50 new solitaires are added in the new game version. A whole series of popular solitaires “Pyramid” was also added to satisfy numerous requests of our customers.

In this new game version, we have dramatically changed the opportunity to adjust the game to your taste. Additional game packs which include colorful card backs and backgrounds collected in difference themes are available now. You can also enjoy new graphic elements of the game, for example nice background pictures and animated winning splash-screen.

Besides, this version supports more new devices with Palm OS 5.0 and higher.

System requirements

The game is designed for devices with Palm OS 3.0 and higher.

There are two different versions of the game:

- for devices with both black-and-white and color low-resolution screens (160x160);
- for devices with both gray scaled and color high-resolution screens (320x320, 320x480, 480x320).

To install the game you should have the following amount of free space (on a Storage Card or in the Main Memory):

- 500 KB on devices with low-resolution screens;
- 800 KB on devices with high-resolution screens;
- 600 KB will take the winning splash-screen (WinMovie.prc) on devices with color high-resolution screens.

Moreover, the game requires some amount of free operating memory to run properly:

- 150 KB on devices with black-and-white low-resolution screens;
- 300 KB on devices with color low-resolution screens;
- 800 KB on devices with high-resolution screens.

Registration and demo-version limitations

The longer you play the unregistered game, the more often you see the message about registration procedure when starting a new solitaire. To register your copy of the game you should enter the registration code in the following dialog: menu “Options>Register...”



[Additional theme packs](#) need their own registration codes. To register a theme you should do the following:

- install the pack on your device (the «One for All 250 Solitaires Collection» game should be installed earlier).
- select the installed theme in the pop-up list in the «Options>Themes...» menu and tap the «OK» button. In the appeared window enter the registration code.

You can get an appropriate registration code after buying the game or an additional theme pack. Read the [How to get the registration code](#) section for more details.

Installation

1. Back up all data from your mobile device to your desktop PC or to extension card.
2. Run the “Palm Desktop” program on your desktop computer (right after the installation, the “Palm Desktop” icon is on the desktop). Then click the “Install Tool” icon in the “Palm Desktop” window.



Or use the “Quick Install” application (right after the installation, its icon is on the desktop too).

3. In the appeared window add the file:
 - Solitaires-hi.prc - the game version for devices with high-resolution screens;
 - Solitaires-lo.prc - the game version for devices with low-resolution screens;
 - WinMovie.prc - the winning splash-screen for devices with color high-resolution screens;
 - *.pdb – the additional theme pack* for devices with color high-resolution screens.

To add a file into the “Install Tool” window you should drag-&-drop the file there or press the “Add” button and set location of the file you want to add.

4. Press the “Done” button.
5. Synchronize your device with the desktop computer using the “HotSync” program. After synchronization “One for All 250 Solitaires Collection” will be installed. To start the game, tap its icon.



How to play

Main game menu





If you start the game, first of all you will see the splash-screen. Then you will proceed to the main game menu. It looks like in the picture below.




In the main game menu, there are two sections and four buttons.

- The most popular games are listed in the “Favorites” section. You can change this list by adding your favorite games to it.
- All available solitaires are listed in the “All games” section. Solitaires with similar rules are gathered in separate folders.
- To open a solitaire you should select it in the list and tap the “Play” button.
- To look at the demonstration of any solitaire you should select it and tap the “Demo” button.
- To read the rules and to learn complexity and chance of winning of the selected solitaire please use the “Rules” button.
- To exit the main game menu please use the “Cancel” button.

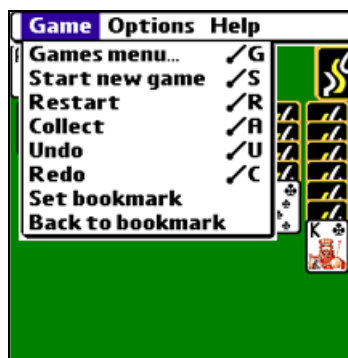
Moreover, all solitaires are divided in four types:



-  - gambling game;
-  - time-consuming game;
-  - game of luck;
-  - complicated game (you will have to think a lot).

Game menu

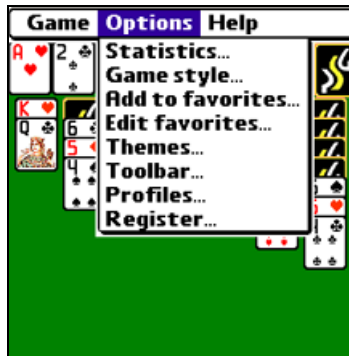
In each solitaire, there is a menu of three sections. To open the menu you should tap the “Menu” icon in the Graffiti field. The other way to open any menu item is to use the special Graffiti stroke  and the appropriate letter.

The first menu section – “Game”



- Use the item “Game>Games menu...” if playing a certain solitaire you want to open another one.
- Use the item “Game>Start new game” to deal once again in the current solitaire.
- Use the item “Game>Restart” to deal once again the same solitaire.
- Use the item “Game>Collect” to move all cards to suitable positions.
- Use the item “Game>Undo” to undo the latest move. Using this menu item you can cancel any number of your moves one by another. You can also use the button .
- Use the item “Game>Redo” or tap the button  to redo the latest move .
- Use the menu item «Game>Bookmark» to make a bookmark on the current card positions if while playing you see two possible ways of making your move (two possible ways of the further collecting the current solitaire). If you do not like the card positions, which was bookmarked, you can choose the menu item «Game>Undo» and the bookmark will be deleted.
- Use the menu item «Game>Return to bookmark» to return to the saved card positions. If you created several bookmarks, the operation «Game>Return to bookmark» will return you to the latest bookmark.

The second menu section – “Options”

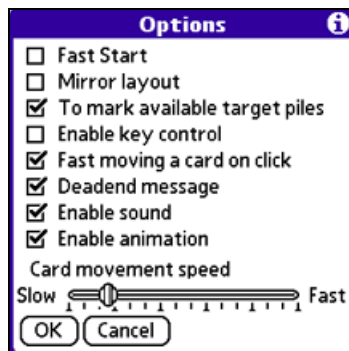


- To see statistics of the current game use the item “Options>Statistics...” In the appeared window you will see how many times you have played the current solitaire, how many times you have won and lost the game and the total sum for all money games.



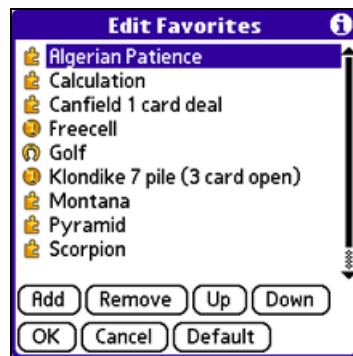
Tap the screen to close this window.

- To change game settings use the item “Options>Game style...”



- To switch off animation of cards dealing you should put a tick near the item “Fast Start”.
- To mirror cards layout you should check the item “Mirror layout”. Using this option you can set a convenient cards layout in asymmetrical solitaires. This option can be especially useful for left-handers as it allows to move the interface elements on places easily accessible by the left hand.
- To disable the prompts of available target piles you should uncheck the item “To mark available target piles”.

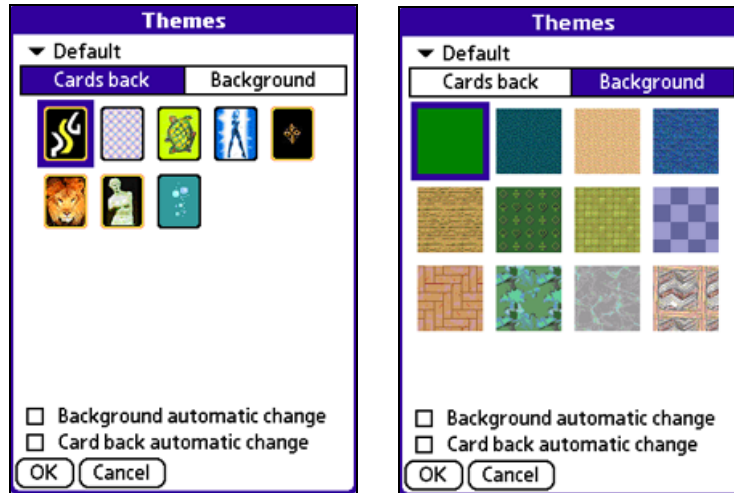
- To move cards with pressing hardware buttons you should put a tick near the item “Enable key control”. Such moving cards are available only for devices with hardware build-in keyboard.
 - To disable [quick moving cards](#) on click you should uncheck the item “Fast moving a card on click”.
 - To disable appearing the message “No moves left” you should uncheck the item “Deadend message”.
 - To disable moving cards sound you should uncheck the item “Deadend message”.
 - To switch on animation of cards moving you should put a tick near the item “Enable animation”.
 - To tune the speed of cards moving use the slider “Card movement speed”.
 - To apply changes tap the “OK” button.
 - To cancel changes and exit the current window tap the “Cancel” button.
- To add the current solitaire to Favorites use the item “Options>Add to favorites...”
 - The menu item “Options>Edit favorites...” is designed to edit the “Favorites” list.



In this window you can do the following:

- Add the current solitaire to “Favorites” – the “Add” button;
- Remove the current solitaire from “Favorites” – the “Remove” button, but if the current solitaire is the only game in “Favorites”, you will not be able to remove it;
- Change games sequence – the buttons “Up” and “Down”;
- To apply changes tap the “OK” button;
- To cancel changes and exit the current window tap the “Cancel” button;
- To restore the list of “Favorites” tap the “Default” button.

- If you open the menu and tap “Options>Themes...”, you will be able to choose one of available card backs or backgrounds from the default build-in pack or additional packs. You can install additional pack separately (please find more details in the [Additional features](#) section).



To change cards back or background you should:

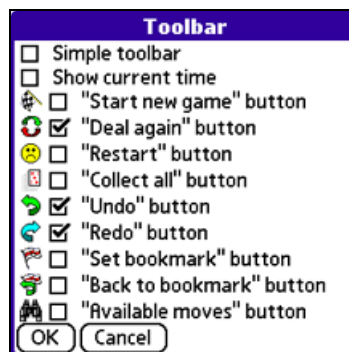
- In the pop-up menu select the theme from which you want to choose cards back or background.
- Select the “Cards back” or “Background” section.
- Select a card back or background that you like.










Moreover:

- To change backgrounds randomly at the start of a new game check the “Background automatic change” box.
- To change cards back randomly at the start of a new game check the “Card back automatic change” box.

To save changes and exit the current window tap the “OK” button. Otherwise tap the “Cancel” button.

- The menu item “Options> Toolbar...” is designed to edit the toolbar in the main game window. Using this menu item you can add necessary buttons to the toolbar or remove useless buttons.



- To set the standard toolbar typical for Palm OS you should check the “Simple toolbar” item.
- To see the current time on the toolbar you should check the “Show current time” box.
- To add necessary buttons to the toolbar you should check appropriate items from the following list:
 -  the «Start new game» button – to deal once again in the current solitaire;
 -  the «Deal again» button – to deal once again;
 -  the «Restart» button – to deal once again the same solitaire;
 -  the «Collect all» button – all cards will be moved to suitable positions;
 -  the «Undo» button – to undo the latest move;
 -  the «Redo» button – to redo the latest move;
 -  the «Set bookmark» button – to make a bookmark on the current card positions;
 -  the «Back to bookmark» button – to return to the saved card positions;
 -  the «Available moves» button – to see available moves.

To save changes and exit the current window tap the “OK” button. Otherwise tap the “Cancel” button.

- The menu item “Options> Profiles...” is designed to add and edit profiles in the game. This version of the game supports the multi-user feature. Each user can play under his personal profile and save his game settings and his personal statistics.



In this window you can:

- Select a profile in the list.
- Set an active profile. This profile will be launched by default next time you start the game.
- Rename the selected profile – the «Rename» button;
- Set password for the selected profile – the «Password» button;

- Create a new profile – the «New» button. A new profile will have all games settings of the current profile and clean statistics.
- Delete any profile – the «Delete» button. But if the current profile is the only profile in the list, you will not be allowed to delete it.
- Activate selecting profile at the game start – check the «Select profile at start» box.

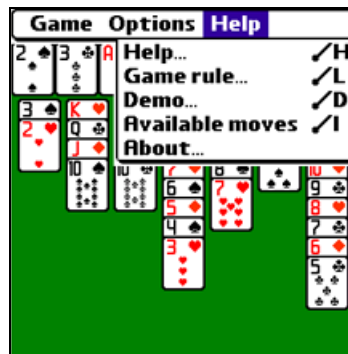
To save changes and exit the current window tap the “Done” button.

- To register your copy of the game you should enter the registration code and tap the “OK” button in the menu “Options>Register...”.



To exit this window tap the “Cancel” button.

The third menu section – “Help”



- Use the item “Help>Help...” to read help about general game features
- Use the item “Help>Game rule...” to read the rules and to learn complexity and chance of winning of the current solitaire. Solitaire rules are available only in English.
- Use the item “Help>Demo...” to see the demonstration of the current solitaire. To exit demonstration tap at any place on the screen.
- Use the item “Help>Available moves” to see available moves.
- Use the item “Help>About ...” to see the information about this game.

Card moving

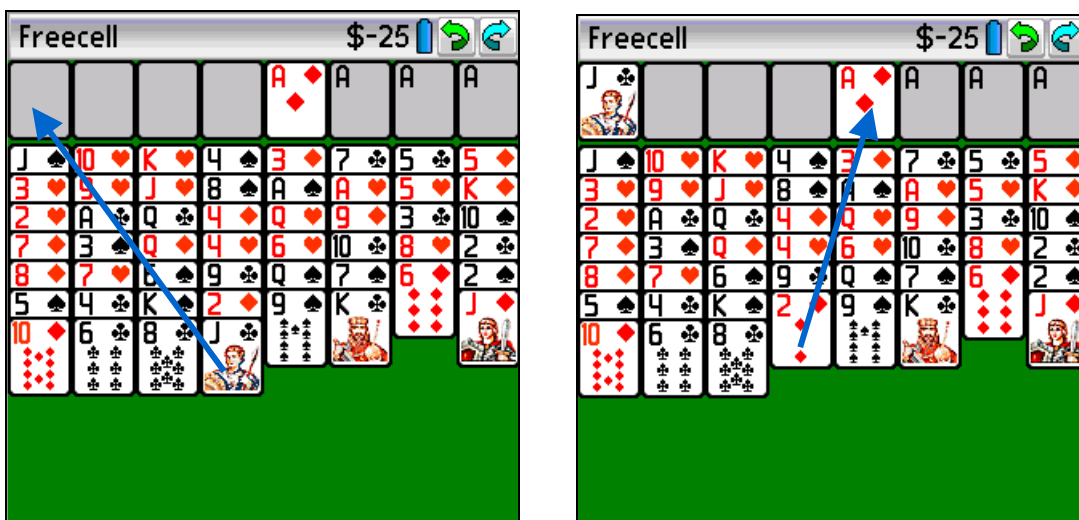
To move a card or a pile of cards you should tap and drag it to a new place (without raising the stylus from the screen).

Quick card moving

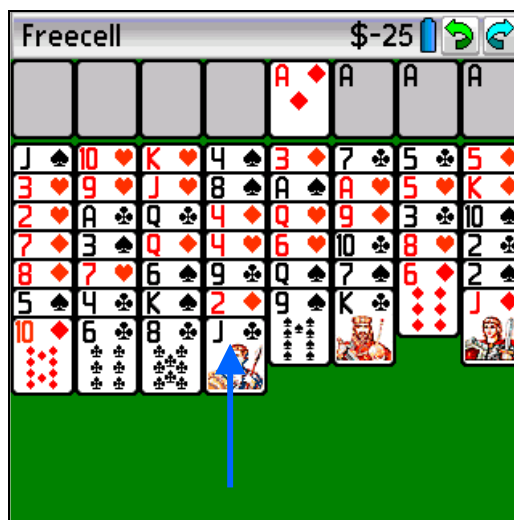
You can also perform quick card moving. To do this, tap once a card or a pile of cards. The program will automatically move the card(s) to suitable positions. Sometimes there are several suitable positions to move the card(s) to and the program may use any of them. If you expected a card to be moved to another position, just tap this card again and it will be moved there automatically.

Complex card moving

- Let us take an example. While playing one of “Freecell” solitaires you want to move two cards (one after another) to suitable positions. In this case you should move the first (upper) card to a vacant position (free cell) in the top line first, the second card – to a position you want, and then the first card to a position you want.



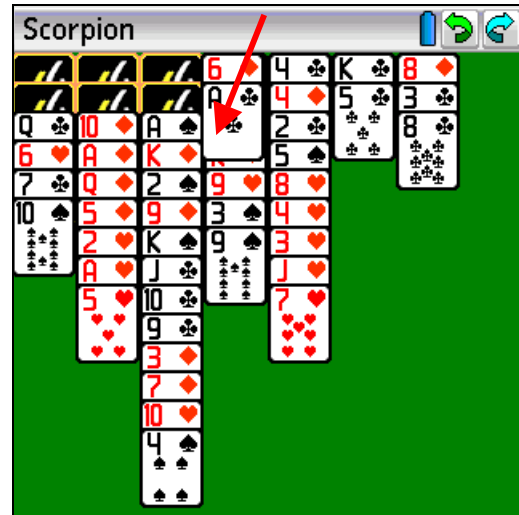
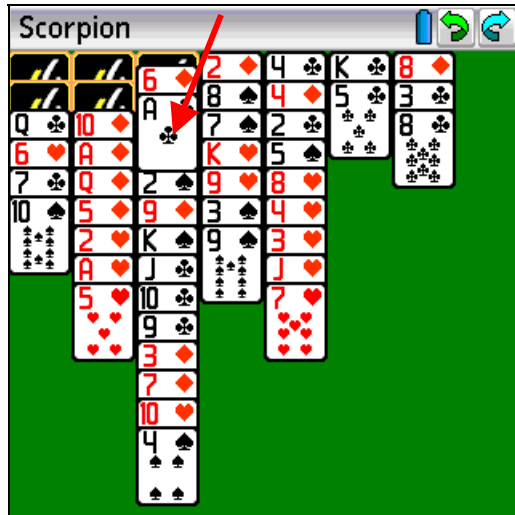
The program can perform all this sequence of actions instead of you. Just tap the first card by the stylus.



- All cards can also be moved to suitable positions by tapping the menu item “Game>Collect”.

Long piles of cards

If you have built up a long pile of cards on the screen, the long pile will be stacked into several layers so that last cards will be shown above first cards. To see cards placed under the upper layer you should tap the upper layer by stylus and it will move to the right for some time. Tap the moved aside card(s) again to move them back.



Game exit

To exit the game any time you wish, tap the “HOME” icon in the Graffiti field, please. The current game will be saved and will be restored when you start the game again.

Additional features

(for devices with color high-resolution screens only)

In the game version 2.0 there are the following additional features for devices with color high-resolution screens:

- You can install the animated winning splash-screen in addition (on a Storage Card or in the main memory). You can install the WinMovie.prc file in the same way as the main game file (please see more details in the **Installation** section).
- Together with the new version of the game itself, we have released additional packs of backgrounds and card backs collected in different themes. You can install any additional pack in the same way as the main game file (please see more details in the **Installation** section). Any pack can be installed on a Storage Card or in the main memory.



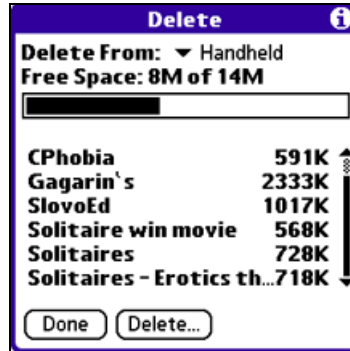
Attention! Additional theme packs are sold separately from the game and need their own registration codes. The registration code for the game will not register an additional theme. Read the **How to get the registration code** section for more details.

To register a theme you should do the following:

- install the pack on your device (the «One for All 250 Solitaires Collection» game should be installed earlier).
- select the installed theme in the pop-up list in the «Options>Themes...» menu and tap the «OK» button. In the appeared window enter the registration code.

Uninstallation

To completely uninstall the game “One for All 250 Solitaires Collection” from your device you should go to the “Applications” screen, open the menu and tap “App > Delete”. Then select “Solitaires” and tap the “Delete” button.



To remove additional themes or the winning splash-screen from your device you should go to the “Applications” screen, open the menu and tap “App > Delete”. Then select «Solitaires-Erotics th...» or «Solitaire win movie» and tap the “Delete” button.
